




Students have access to the eBook through the hamburger menu in the upper left corner of the page. Select eBook to open.





As students click on a term, a glossary will appear and define the word in context of what is covered within that section.



There are also helpful student annotation notes (or footnotes) written by the author, which gives students more context around what they're learning. In-line videos allow the students to watch a video on the concept they are viewing.



To highlight and keep notes, students can drag and click the Highlight annotation button. The note will save for later reference. Students can click on both highlights and notes to save them by chapter with timestamps. They can also select the text to enable the Read-Aloud feature.



When in an assignment, a student is able to click on the eBook icon on the right hand side and the eBook will open to the section in which the topic is covered. They can then click on the Chapter to open up a screen view and use the textbook for support.
