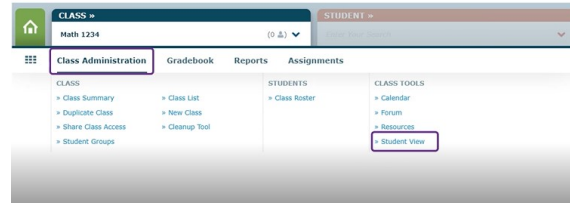
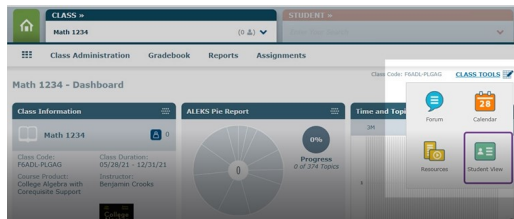
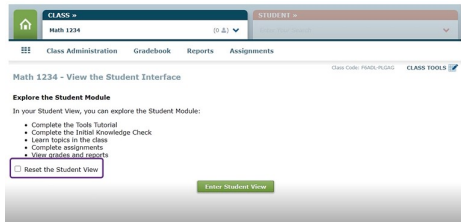


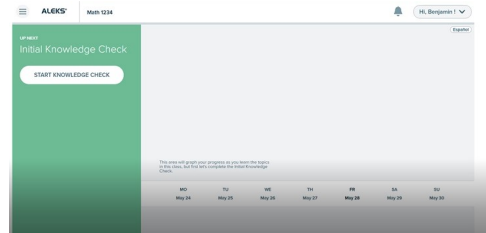
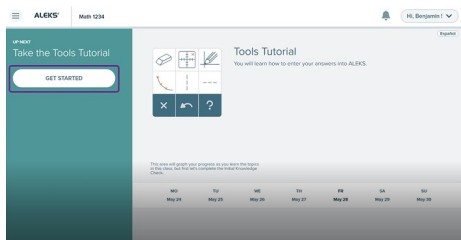
1. To start, enter Student View by either clicking Class Tools, then Student View, or rolling over Class Administration, then clicking Student View. Click Enter Student View.



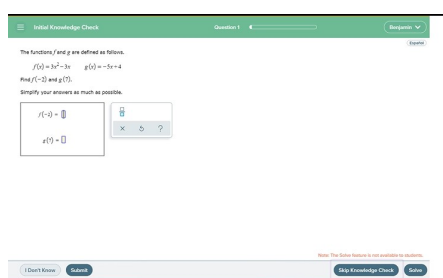
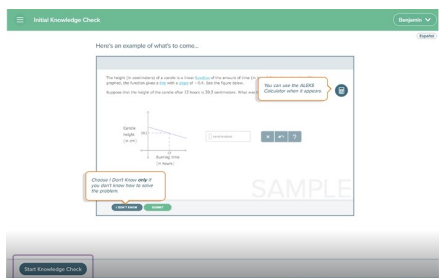
2. Click Enter Student View or, if you would like to simulate an entire experience, check the Reset the Student View box before entering Student View.



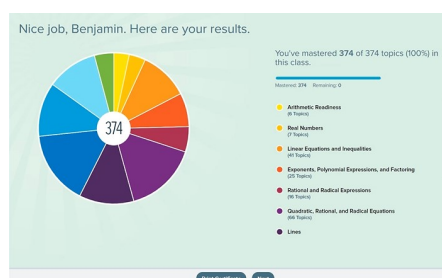
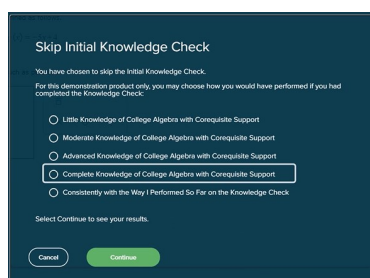
3. Next, you will be asked to start the tutorial, which may be skipped by instructors. Click the button to start the Knowledge Check then check Skip Tooltips if desired.



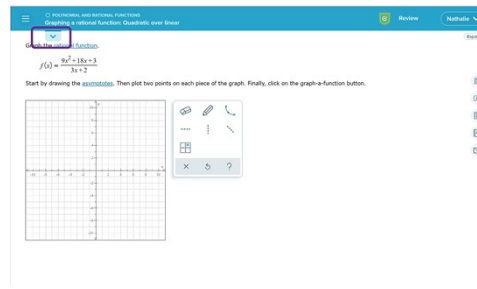
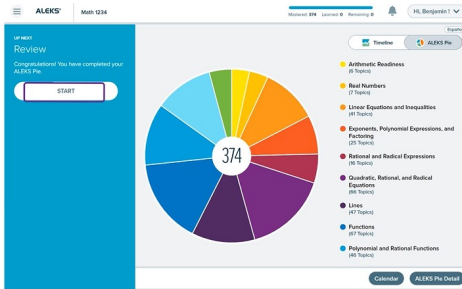
4. Click Start Knowledge Check, then once the first question appears, click Skip Knowledge Check. This button is only available to instructors.



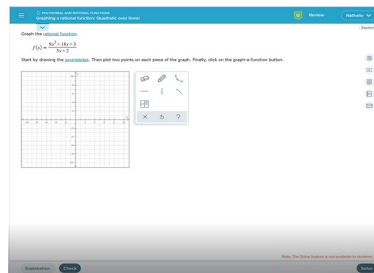
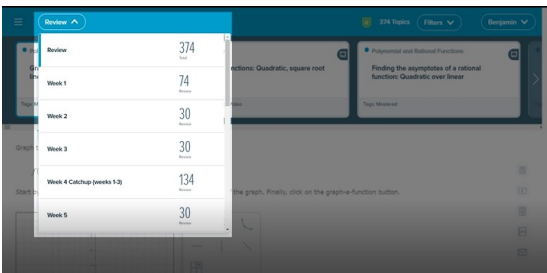

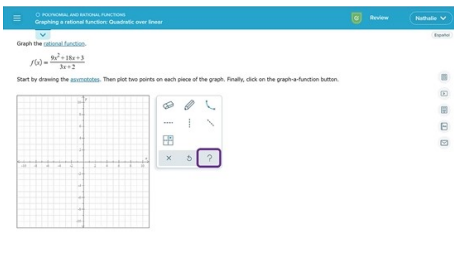
6. Once on the homepage, click Start to enter the review mode. To select an Objective and topic, click the arrow to open the topic carousel.
