


Connect Question Bank: Add Study Attempts

“Study attempts” allow students to re-complete questions from an assignment for further studying, without affecting their grades.

How to Add Study Attempts

Click on the assignment from the assignments page. From the assignment options menu, select “edit assignment” and “continue” to view the policies page.




Click “expand advanced settings” and under “Attempts,” click “edit” to the right of Attempts. At the bottom, you’ll see the option “allow for study attempts.” Select the checkbox to add Study Attempts to the assignment.



Note that if you enable study attempts, you *cannot* allow late submissions. If you enable study attempts and late submissions, you will receive an error message prompting you to change that setting

to “automatically submit assignments on the due date.”



If any student starts a study attempt, you will no longer be able to change the due date of that assignment.



Additionally, a student who has started a study attempt will no longer be eligible for an extension.



After you’ve added study attempts to an assignment, when a student logs in, they will see the word STUDY under the assignment name. When they begin that assignment in study attempts mode, none of the credit will apply to their final score and they will no longer be eligible for an extension.
