

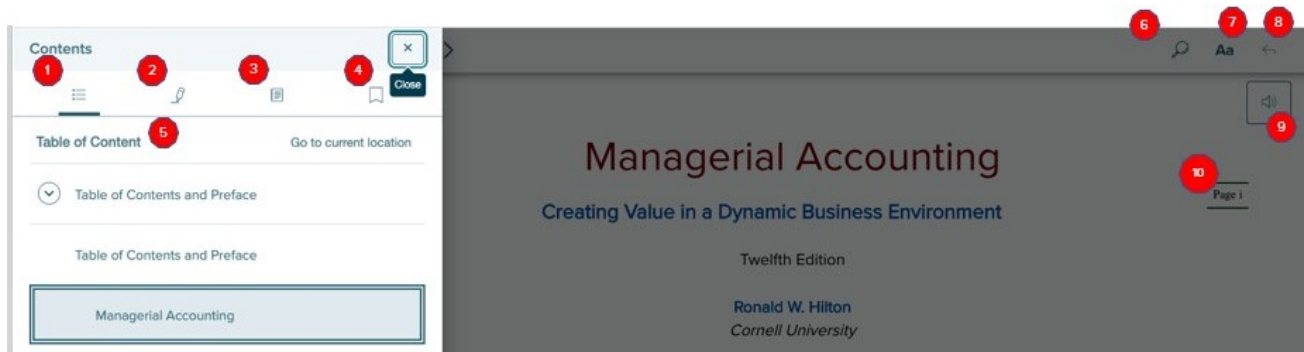

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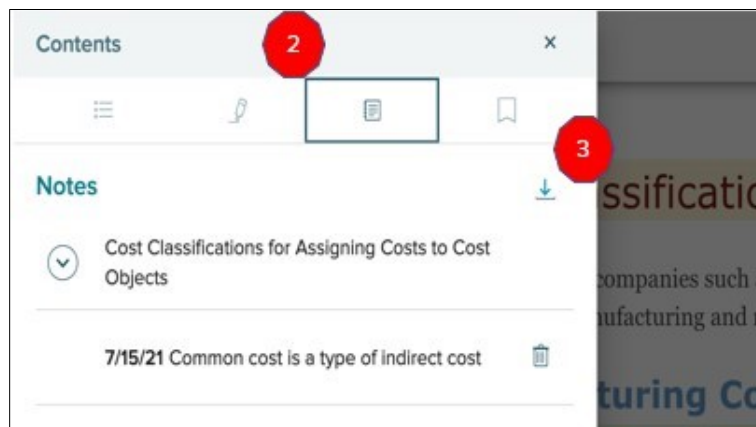
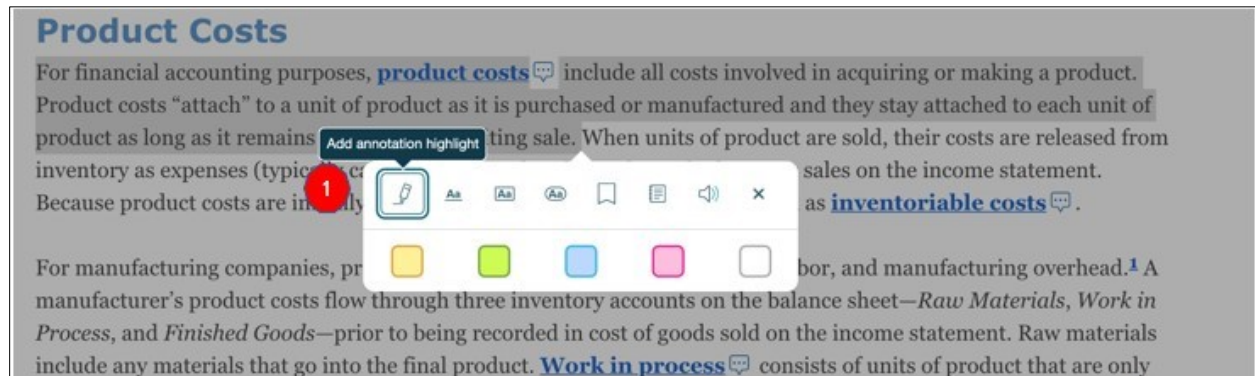


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If you would like to create a study guide for yourself or take notes while reading, you can do that in the eBook using the annotation tools.
