



Managing Assignments with Deleted Questions



Evergreen Delivery Model Overview

The Evergreen delivery model provides you with new and updated content, tools and accessibility features delivered directly to your existing courses without the hassle of a new edition.

Titles receive updates as part of “digital releases” to your courses in Connect. As part of these updates, some questions may need to be deleted to ensure they continue to align with the text content, the latest accessibility guidelines, and the overall quality of the course content. These questions, along with their point value, will be removed from existing assignments when you duplicate or copy an existing course.

Notifications within your Connect section will alert you of any assignments that have been impacted by the deletion of questions.

Connect Section Dashboard

1) Check your Connect dashboard for alerts.

On your Connect section dashboard, you'll see an indicator on the assignments tab and a notification in the assignment overview section alerting you that some assignments need review

2) Go to the Assignments tab to find impacted assignments.
