



## Polling Overview

Polling is a tool to monitor student participation, assess understanding in real time, and track student attendance. To begin, start on your course section dashboard and select the tab titled “polling”.

Next, click the “create new poll” button. Name your new poll in the “poll title” box. Give it a specific name so you can easily find it when ready to use in class. After giving your poll a name, you can begin creating questions. Question title is an optional field, making the question easier

to recognize when looking at your poll overview and student results. It is not viewable by students. If you do not create a question title, the tool will use the first 100 characters from your Question Prompt as the title. Question Prompt is the question you will be asking your students. This will be viewable to students when you share your screen in the Conduct Poll view.

The default number of answer choices is two, however a question may have up to five answer choices by selecting the “Add choice” button. Once you have created your answer choices, select one of the options to be correct or indicate no correct answer. You can add up to 10 questions per poll. When complete, select the “continue” button to advance in the poll creation process.

This page will give you an overview of the poll you just created, including settings to choose from. To see a description of each setting, select the information icon.

You have now created a poll! If you want to edit the poll, click the three dots expanded menu under the options column. Select “Edit Poll.”

This will take you back to the Poll Overview page where you can edit the “poll title” and/or “poll settings,” add questions, or delete questions. Selecting the Edit button will allow you to edit individual questions. Note this can only be accessed while the poll is in the “Not Started” state.

If you would like to duplicate a poll, click the three dots drop down menu and select duplicate poll. Your poll will be duplicated and added to the top of the table in the Not Started state. All questions and settings will be the same as the original poll. Note if

you copy a course section in Connect, polls will automatically copy along with it.
