

SmartBook: Grading and Recharge for Students

Video Walkthrough: CLICK TO VIEW

SmartBook assignment scores are are based on number of points accumulated **before** the due date. Your score locks in when you **either** achieve 100% completion **OR** the due date arrives, whichever happens first.

After the due date passes, the assignment automatically goes into *recharge mode* and you can continue to work the assignment for additional study. Work completed in recharge mode will not affect your original score.

In the student view of Connect, you will see the **RECHARGE** indication under the assignment name.



Clicking the assignment will show a popup box explaining that you will not receive any additional credit or any further progress in recharge mode. Click "**Recharge.**"

Click Start Reading to be taken to where you last left off in the SmartBook. Click Start Questions to begin working on the adaptive assignment.
