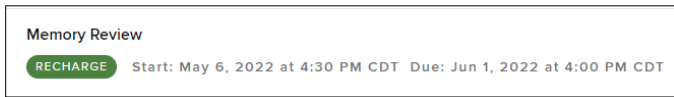


## SmartBook: Grading and Recharge for Students

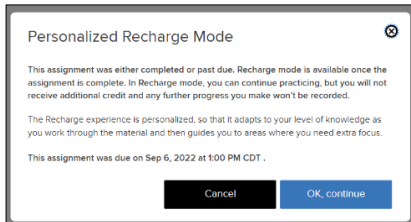

SmartBook assignment scores are based on number of points accumulated **before** the due date. Your score locks in when you **either** achieve 100% completion **OR** the due date arrives, whichever happens first.

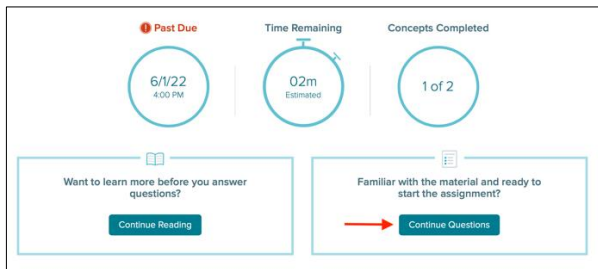
**After** the due date passes, the assignment automatically goes into *recharge mode* and you can continue to work the assignment for additional study. Any work you complete in recharge mode will not affect your original score.



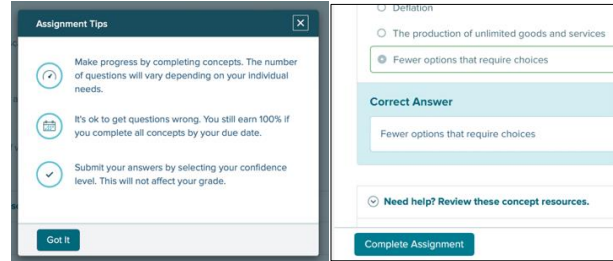
In the student view of Connect, you will see the **RECHARGE** indication under the assignment name.



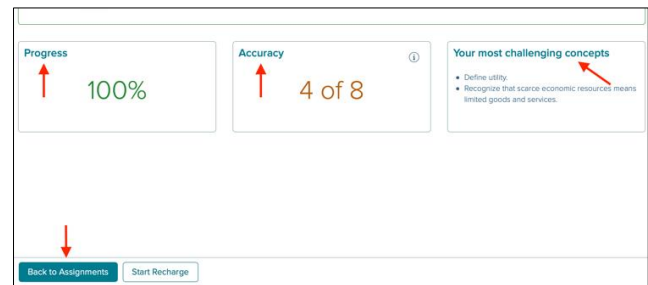
Clicking the assignment will show a popup box explaining that you will not receive any additional credit or any further progress in recharge mode. Click **“OK, continue.”**



The assignment will be shown as **past due**. Click **“Continue questions.”**

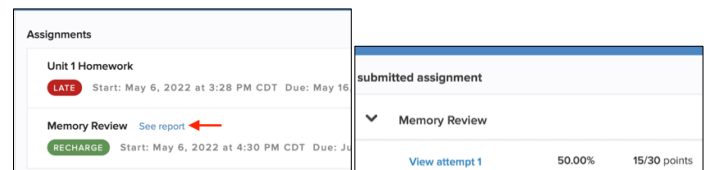


Before the assignment opens, tips for completing it will pop up. When you have completed the assignment in recharge mode, click **“Complete Assignment.”**



Next, you'll see several pieces of data. **Progress** shows your completion percentage, including before and after the due date. **Accuracy** shows how many questions you answered to achieve the minimum number of correct answers required, also before and after the due date.

Lastly, **your most challenging learning concepts** shows a customized list that you can use as a study guide. Remember, neither progress nor accuracy reflect your actual score, which is based solely on the number of correct answers you acquire before the due date. To see your actual score, click **“back to assignments”** where you will see a list of all your assignments.



Click **“see report”** to see the total score earned *before* the due date - this does not include questions answered correctly *after* the due date in Recharge mode.
