


Select Your Program

5. Assignments Ready To Grade


These are previous assignments that students have submitted back to you for grading.


6. Toolbar





Lesson Presentations


Click Lesson Presentation inside lesson plans to launch a pre-built presentation.




Using SmartBook®

SmartBook determines precisely which learning objectives a student has grasped and those with which he/she struggles. The resources provides students with additional instruction, practice, and context to build meaning to give them what they need when they need it. The study, practice, and assess learning cycle helps students commit knowledge to long-term memory.







1. Launch SmartBook

Assign and launch *SmartBook* from the lesson level.

2. Create a new SmartBook

Teachers can create their own SmartBook assignments by selecting Assignments from the toolbar and the SmartBook Assignment Type.

3. Explore SmartBook

Students will read through the chapter and practice what they've learned.


Students rate their confidence in each answer, this allows *SmartBook* to ensure future questions address any learning gaps.

If at any time students need to a refresher on the content, they can jump right into the reading and go directly to the source.

4. Reporting & Analytics

Reports help teachers view and measure students growth and progress in learning comprehension.


Class Management and Tools



Managing Groups

Access your **class roster** from the **Roster** button on the Toolbar.

Once in your roster, click **Manage Groups** to set up your classes, send assignments across multiple classes or individual students.



New Assignment

To create a **new assignment** click the **New Assignment** button to select from a variety of assignment options:

Online Questions – select from McGraw Hill assessments, or build your own assignments using questions you select or create.

Instructions – create instructions for gradable offline activity.


Submission – create an assignment that allows students to upload files, submit links, or enter their work directly.

SmartBook 2.0 – create an assignment from SmartBook to help students personalize their learning.


Assessment Center

Assessments
