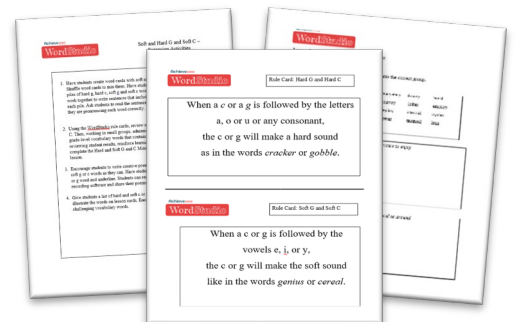
### What are the most important benefits of Achieve3000 WordStudio?
