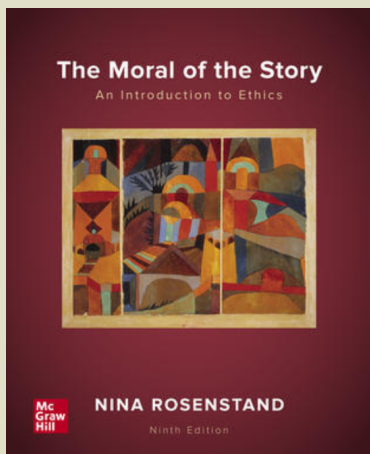

Chapter 1: Thinking About Values

- The Narratives section now includes a summary of the film *The Eichmann Story*, reflecting the discussion in the chapter about the "banality of evil."

- The chapter has been updated with current examples of films and television shows illustrating moral problems.

Chapter 3: Ethical Relativism

- A new introduction discusses the case of a young American missionary losing his life because he intruded on another culture.

- A new box features Plato's feminism in dispute.
- A new box discusses the #MeToo movement.
- The Narrative section now includes the novel (with reference to the TV series) *The Handmaid's Tale*.

Chapter 13: Applied Ethics: A Sampler

- Includes several thoroughly revised sections, such as about the renewed debate about abortion in the United States.
