

Integrating SimNet with Moodle


What you will need:

- A Moodle username and password (instructor)
- A Moodle course (that you are enrolled in as an instructor)
- A SimNet account

By Pairing your Moodle Account and Course with SimNet you will be able to:

1. Establish Single Sign-On (SSO) between Moodle and SimNet.
2. Utilize Grade Sync

1. To get started, enter your Moodle username and password. Click Login.



5. Verify the SimNet URL associated with your school (it should be **deltaed.simnetonline.com**). If the pre-populated URL is incorrect, please enter the correct one (**deltaed.simnetonline.com**). Click Next to proceed **(M)**.



6. **Sign In** with an existing SimNet account (**N**) . If you do not have a SimNet account, please contact your local MHE Representative.



8. You have completed the pairing process. Click *Continue to SimNet* to proceed (Q).




Additional Information:
