
# **Category Analysis Report**


Once inside the report, you can see category results for a single question bank assignment, or compare results for multiple assignments.


# **Student Performance Report**

## **Quick Tip**


Once you identify your at-risk students, you can proactively work with those students on the subject areas they find most challenging and counsel them on how to best use the resources available to them.




# Most Challenging Learning Objectives Report

With this information in hand, you can optimize your class lessons and go over the topics your class as a whole may be challenged by.




