

# Step 1

Log into your Canvas Course from your mobile device's web browser or the Canvas app. Click on a Connect assignment.


**Note:** If this is your first time accessing Connect this term, you will be taken through the **registration process**. Connect mobile access is best configured for a **tablet browser**.




