


Item Analysis

This report provides the average score for each individual question across all students' attempts, the average of best scores, and the average of the most recent attempts on the question.



Category Analysis

This is perhaps the most versatile and insightful of the reports. This report helps determine how your students are performing relative to specific learning objectives and goals and is also a highly effective tool for ensuring that homework and quiz objectives (formative assessment) are aligned with test objectives (or summative assessment.)



This report is highly customizable to determine performance across aspects like learning objectives, difficulty level, and Bloom's taxonomy. This data identifies where students are struggling, allowing you to then remediate through class.

Course Content Review

A secondary use might be for course content review. Before duplicating a course for the next semester, you can assess the effectiveness of your content. Identifying learning objectives that were missed by many students might indicate inadequate course coverage of the objective.
