Step 1

Login in to your Blackboard account and navigate to your course.

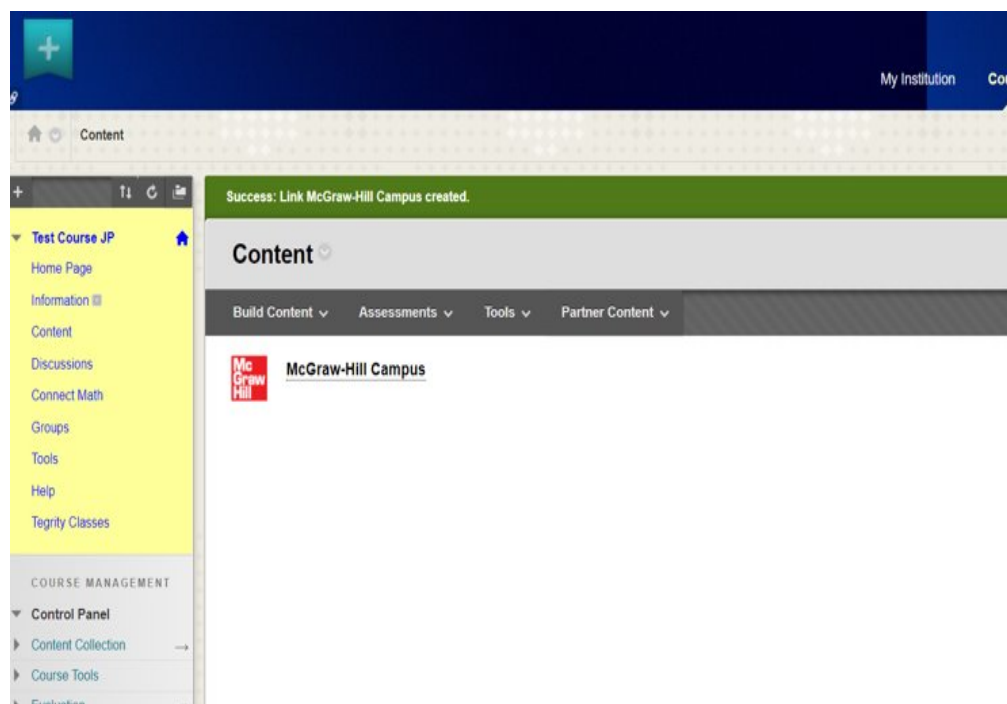
If you are not sure if you have a Blackboard account, check with your instructor.

Step 2

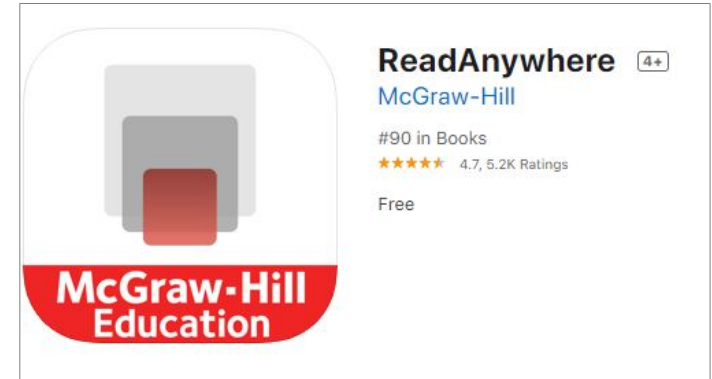

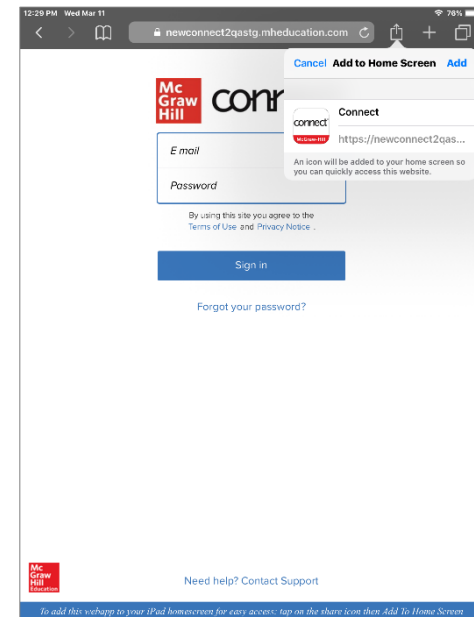
