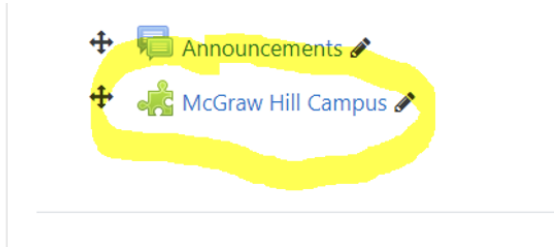
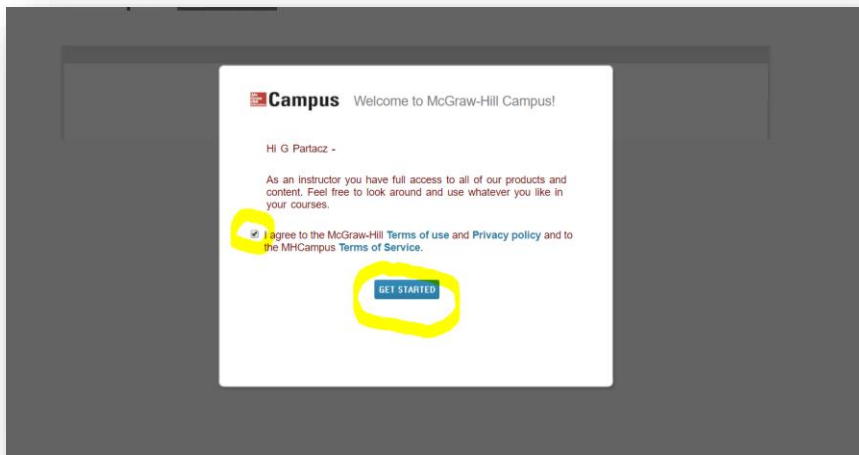


**Step 1.** Log into the LMS and navigate to the course.

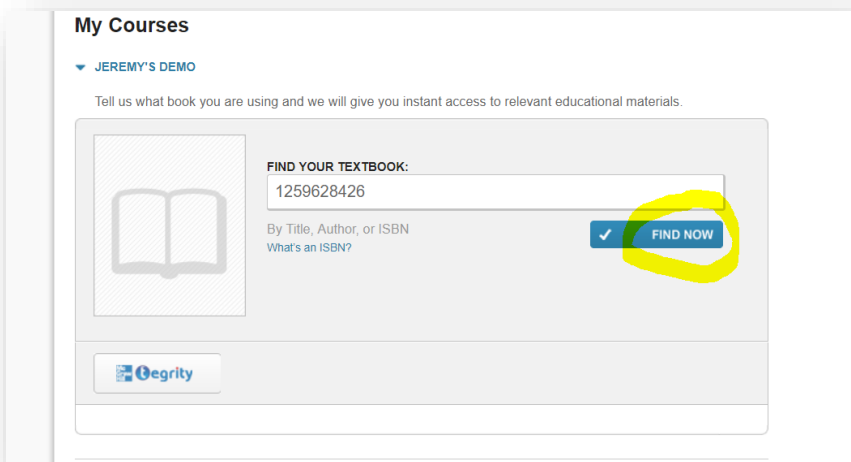
**Step 2.** Locate and click on the McGraw-Hill Campus external tool link.

**Step 4.** In the FIND YOUR TEXTBOOK field, enter title, author, or ISBN of your product. Click **FIND NOW**.



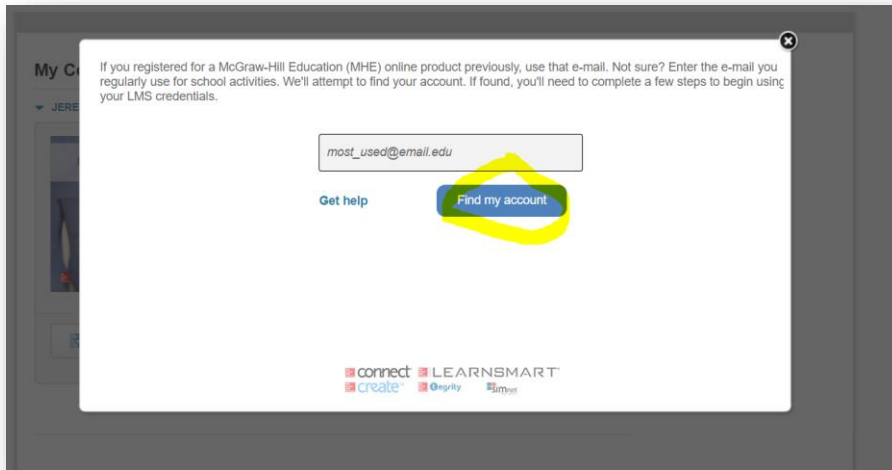
**Step 5.** Once product is located, click **SELECT**.

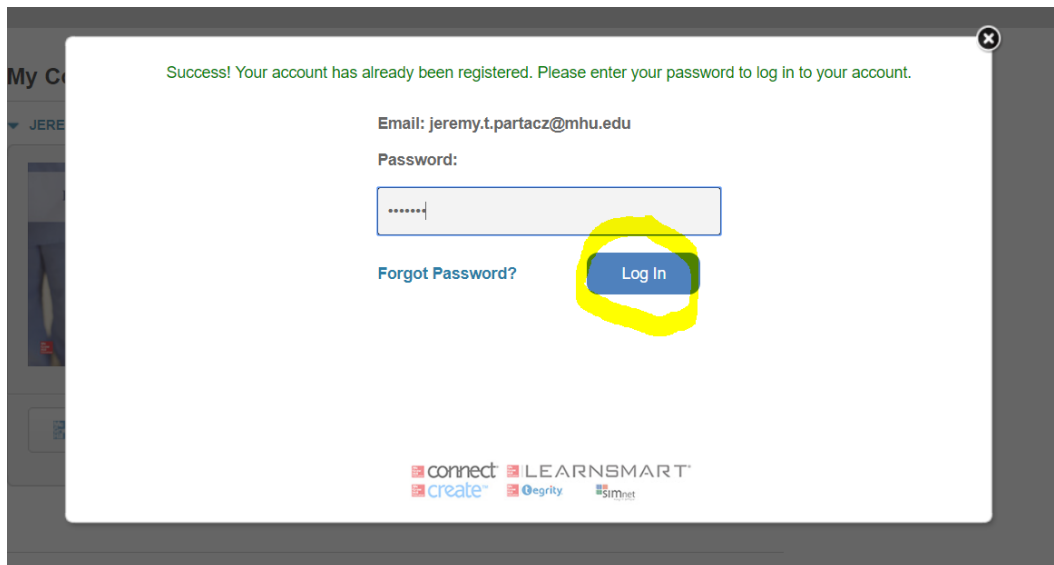

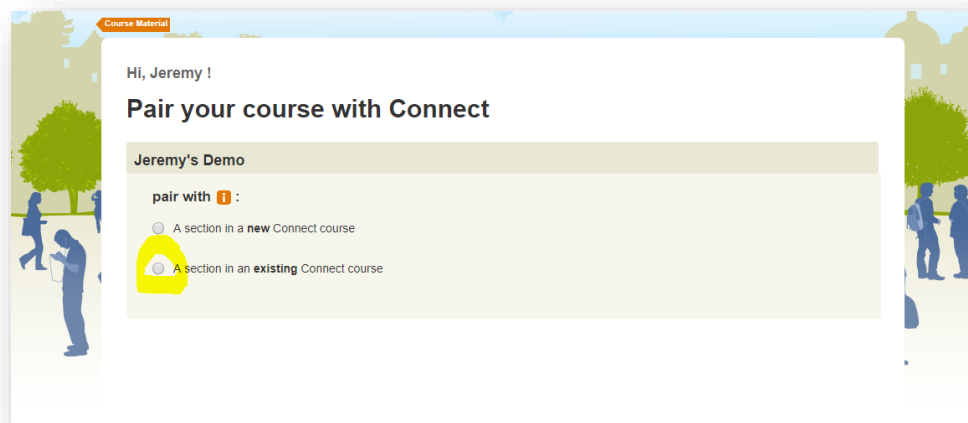
**Step 9.** Click on, “I want this for my students.”



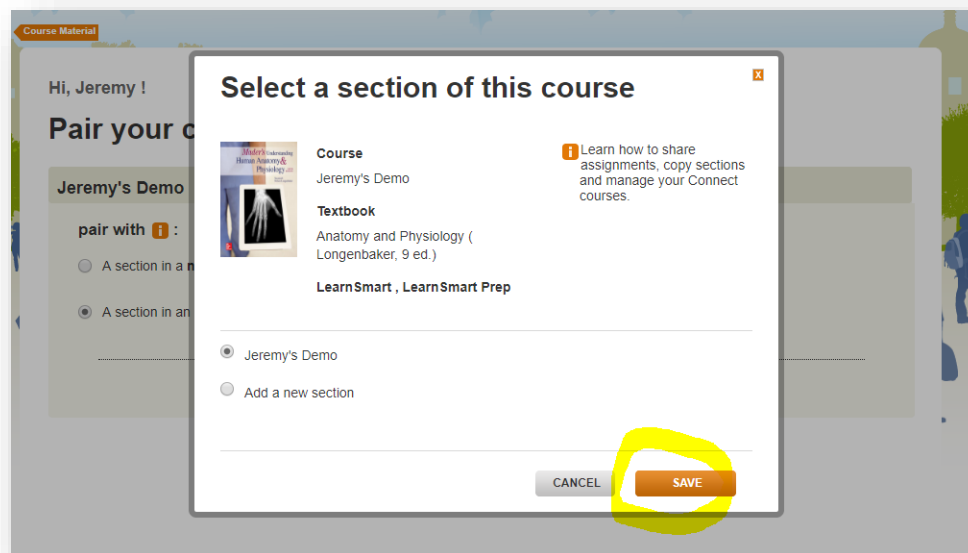
**Step 10.** Click on **ADOPT CONNECT**.
