Step 1

Login in to your Blackboard account and navigate to your course.

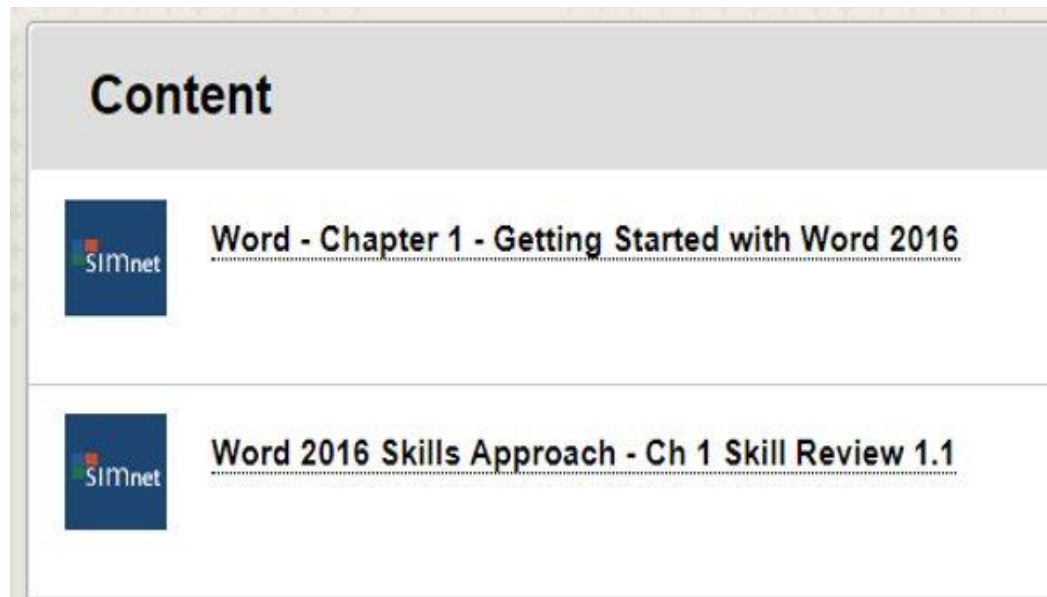
If you are not sure if you have a Blackboard account, check with your instructor.

Step 2

Step 3

Existing SIMnet login: select **Yes, Sign in Now.**


Enter your username and password and click **Sign-in.**



Step 4

You have three registration options.
