If you are not sure if you have a Canvas account, please ask your instructor.

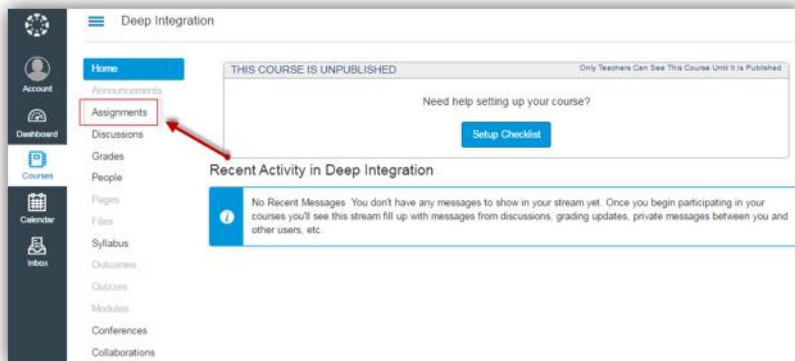

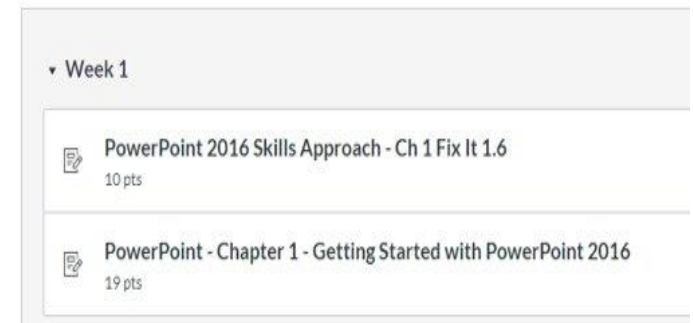
## Step 2

## Step 3

**Existing SIMnet login:** select **Yes, Sign in Now.**


Enter your username and password and click **Sign-in.**


