## Step 1

Login in to your Canvas account and navigate to your course.

If you are not sure if you have a Canvas account, please ask your instructor.



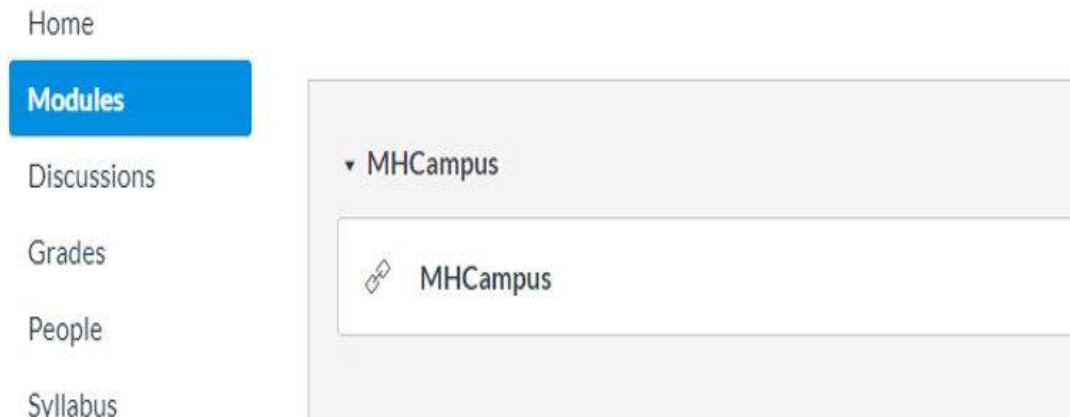

## Step 2

## Step 4

**Existing SIMnet login:** select **Yes, Sign in Now.**


Enter your username and password and click **Sign-in.**

Click **Create Account** to have your account automatically created for you.

## Step 5

You have three registration options.

Once completed, you will be taken to your SIMnet course.
