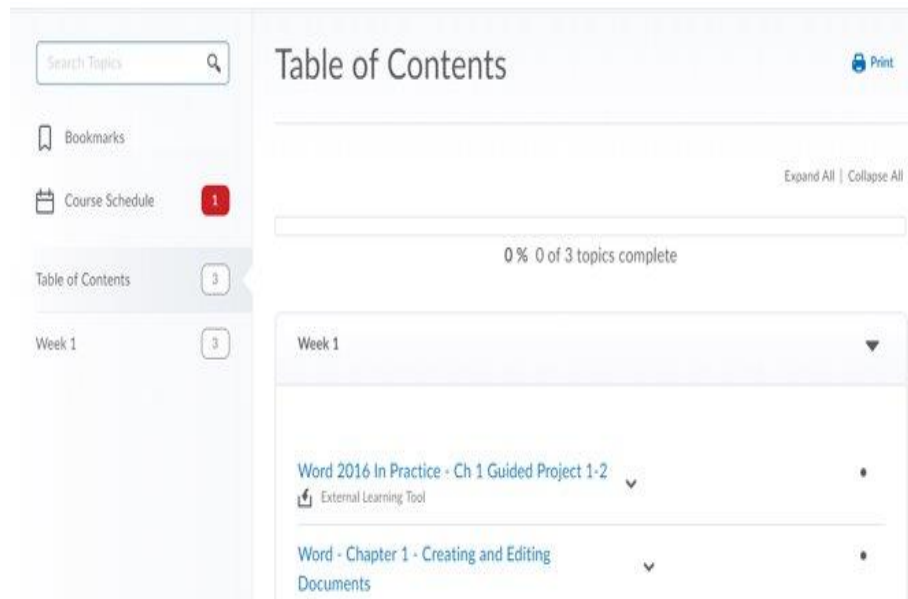

## Step 2

In your course, navigate to your content area to find a SIMnet assignment link. If you're not sure where to go, just ask your instructor.

Click on a SIMnet assignment to start the registration process.





## Step 3

**Existing SIMnet login:** select **Yes, Sign in Now.**

Enter your username and password and click **Sign-in.**

**New to SIMnet:** select **No, Create new account.**

Click **Create Account** to have your account automatically created for you.

## Step 4

3. **Courtesy Access:** Click **Get courtesy access** for two-week temporary access.
