

WHAT IS A BROADWAY JUNIOR PERFORMANCE LICENSE?

Licensing is the process of acquiring the performance rights to a show. It ensures your group complies with Federal Copyright Law, and it is legally required to produce any musical, whether a school group or a professional theater.

Hal Leonard is a distributor and partner with Music Theater International (MTI), and licenses a select group of Broadway Junior musicals either directly or through McGraw Hill. Follow the "**REQUEST**" link on the online order page to begin the ordering process and request a performance license. Musicals are licensed to accredited academic elementary and middle schools with students in grades 9 and lower.
