

MOVING A STUDENT IN ALEKS

Once a student has been enrolled in a class in *ALEKS*, they can be easily moved to a different class without consuming another subscription.

Moving a student to a different class with the same instructor:

If you want to move a student from one of your classes to another class that you also teach, follow these steps to complete this move within ALEKS:

- 1. Create the new class to which you want to move your student(s).
- 2. Go back to the class in which they are currently enrolled.
- **3.** Under Class Administration, select Class Roster.
- Choose the student(s) you wish to move by clicking the checkbox next to their name(s), then click Move in the black bar above the roster.

Moving a student to a different instructor's class at the same school:

An educator with School Level Administrator Access in *ALEKS* can move students from one instructor to another within the same school.

Moving a student to a different school within the same district:

An educator with District Level Administrator Access in *ALEKS* can move students from one school to another within the same district.
