


ADDING RESOURCES IN ALEKS

You can easily add your own resources (documents, notes, and video links) in *ALEKS*. These resources will be available to the student at the point of use when working in *ALEKS*.

- 1. From the Class Tab, click on **Class Tools** just above the dashboard.
- 2. Select Resources in the Class Tools panel.



3. Agree to ALEKS Class Resources Agreement, then click Add Resource.



- 4. Fill out the resource information. You can upload a file, add a web link, or simply type a note.
- **5.** The resource can be added to a folder in the Resources table for general access and can also be linked directly to the topic to which it applies*.
