




Who Is Abraham Lincoln?

Memorial Day is in May.


On Veterans Day, we celebrate veterans.



The Liberty Bell is another symbol.


It rang long ago when the United States became a country.

Many people visit it everyday.





Abraham Lincoln was born in 1809.


He taught himself to read and write.




