**What is happening in this picture?**

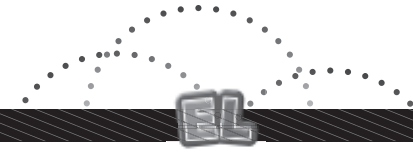
## Talk About the Selection
