sandy said, "but I counted the cars in this train when I went to





the other man said, "yes." then the men left the shed. sandy said to herself, "these men are crooks. they are stealing the tv sets."





sandy said, "but there is a car missing and I found it." then sandy told them all about the missing car.


after she told what had happened, the cop said, "I think there were one hundred cars in that train. how can we check it?"





sam said, "I will go back to the store and get a paper that tells how to make a kite from these parts."





and he did. When he got home, he sat down with his mom. his mom helped him with the paper. When they were done, his mom said, "this paper reads very well. you did a good Job."


sam said, "that's good. now let's make a lot of these papers so we can give one to everybody who wants one."



but he did not con her out of a cone. he conned her out of a bit of ice. she dropped the ice into his mouth. then she said, "now your mouth must feel cool."




