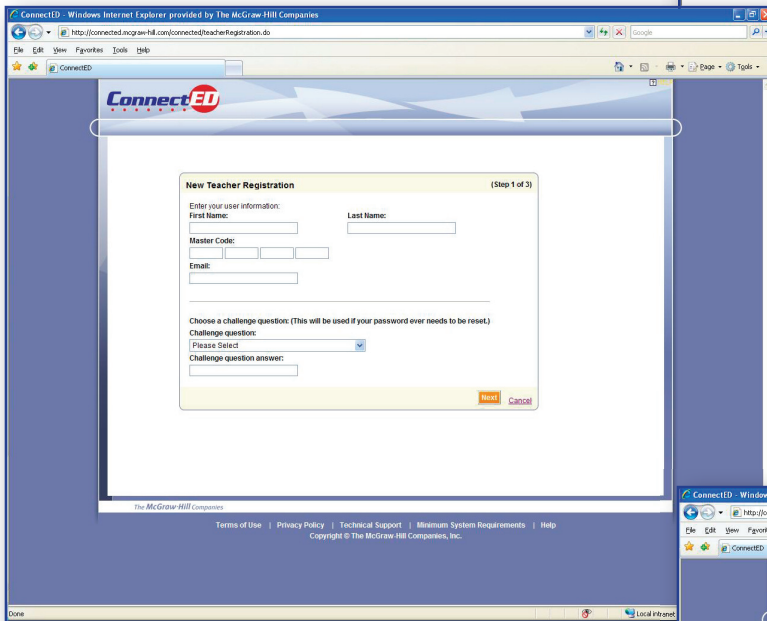
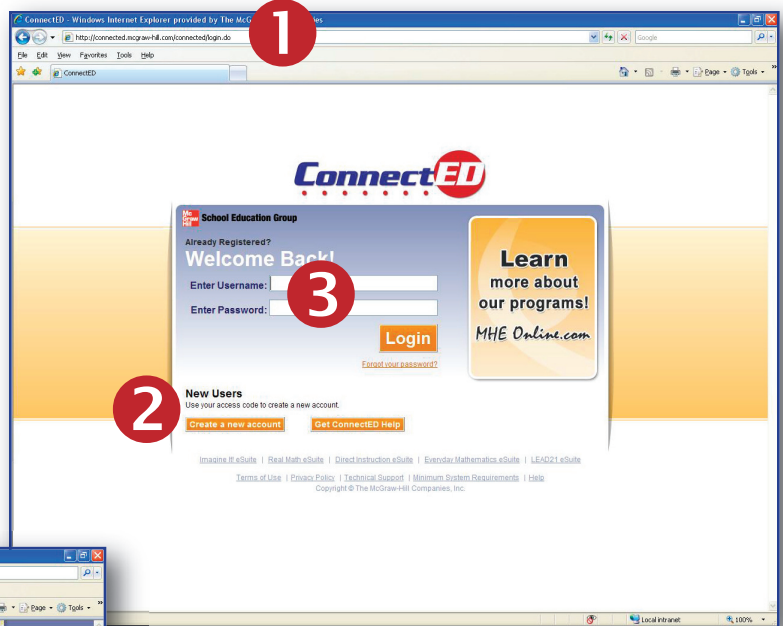

- 3 Enter registered Username and Password

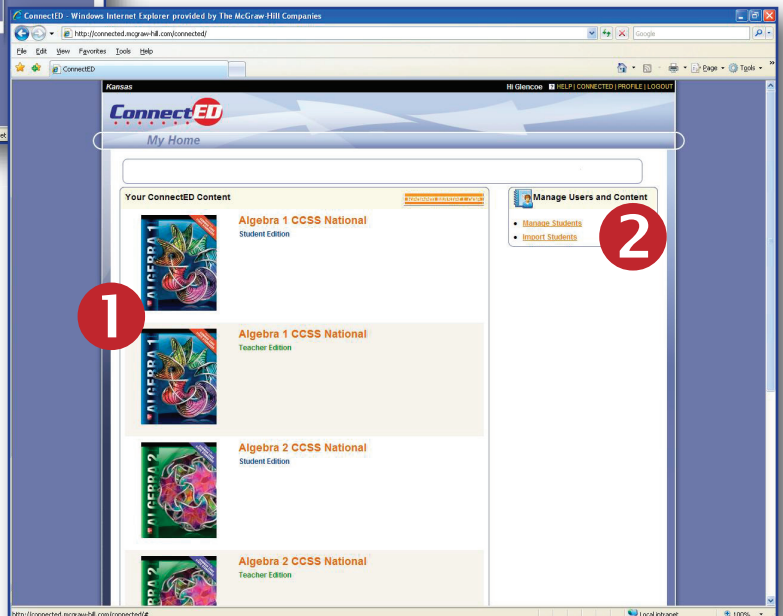

 - Course Resources

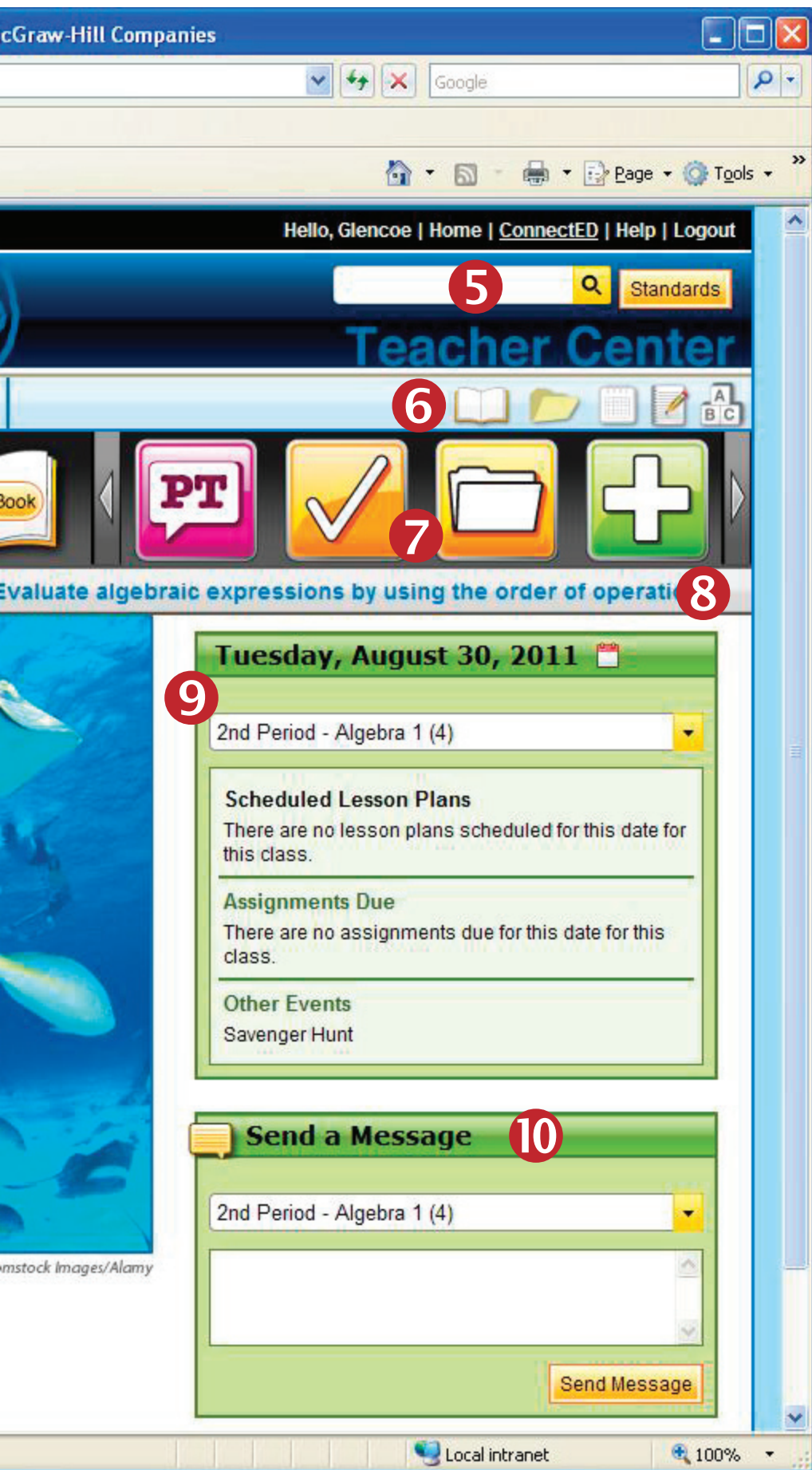
Select a chapter and lesson?

- 4 Use the **Open eBook** icon to open the eTeacher Edition in a new window.

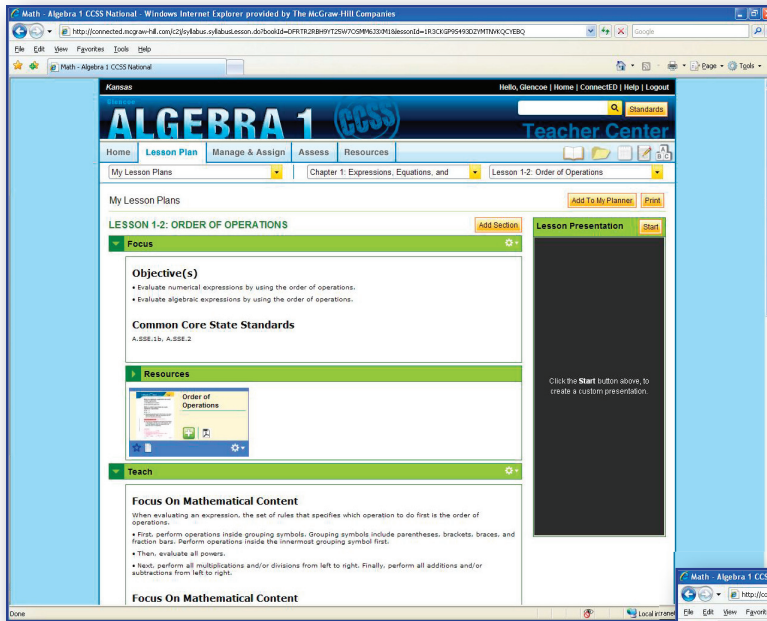

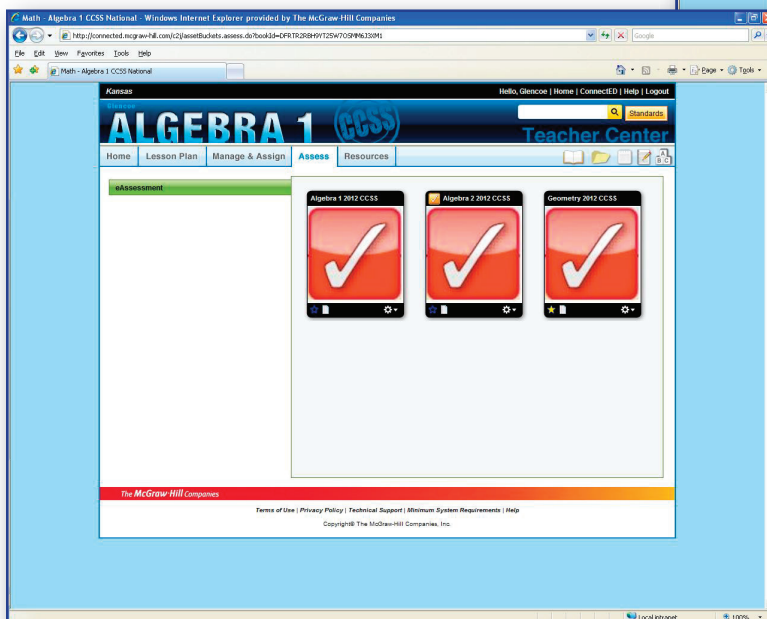
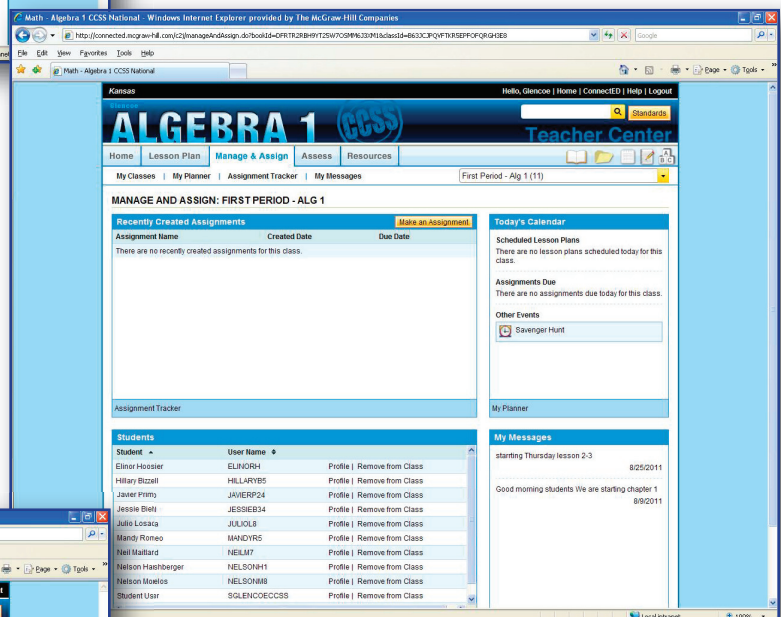
