- 4. Read your answer for item 7. (Call on individual students. Accept answers that are based on the outline and are at least four sentences long.) Example:

Fruits have different coverings. Bananas have peels. Oranges and grapefruits have thick skin. Apples and pears have thin skin that you can eat. 5. Read your answer for item 8. (Call on individual students. Accept answers that are at least five sentences long, tell what Yoshi and his mother said and tell what happened next.) Example:

Yoshi swam to the bottom of the lake and grabbed the shiny object in his fist. Then he swam back to the surface of the lake.

"Look at what I found," he said. Yoshi opened his fist and showed the object to his mother.

"Wow," she said. "That looks like a piece of gold."

6. (Collect papers. Sentences for items 7 and 8 should be punctuated correctly. Make sure item 7 is based on the outline and is at least four sentences long. Make sure item 8 is at least five sentences long, tells what Yoshi and his mother said and tells what happened next.)
