5. Read your answer for item 8. (Call on individual students. Accept stories that are at least five sentences long and tell what Rachel did before and after the middle sentence.)
Example:

Rachel was riding her horse in the woods near her home. Suddenly, she saw a forest fire. She turned her horse around and headed home. Rachel said, "Let's go," and her horse started galloping, with Rachel holding on as hard as she could.

A few minutes later, Rachel arrived at her home. She ran inside to tell her parents about the forest fire.

6. (Collect papers. Sentences for items 7 and 8 should be punctuated correctly. Make sure item 7 summarizes what Ahmed did. Make sure item 8 is at least five sentences long and tells what Rachel did before and after the middle sentence.)
