Pronouns: Possessives

Possessive pronouns take the place of possessive nouns.

Rule

Some possessive pronouns are used before a noun: my, your, his, her, its, our, your, and their.

Some possessive pronouns are used alone: mine, your, his, hers, its, ours, yours, and theirs.

Example

Dan brought **Dan's** football. Dan brought **his** football.

That fishing boat belongs to **Beth.** It is **hers.**
