### Activity: Cryptogram

What to do: A cryptogram is a coded puzzle. For thousands of years, cryptograms have been used to send secret messages. Clever people can study a code and figure out the message. In a cryptogram, the letters stand for other letters. To solve a cryptogram, look at the short words first. For example, a single letter would be <u>a</u> or <u>I</u>. Two letter words that are common are <u>an</u>, <u>at</u>, <u>in</u>, <u>he</u>, and <u>to</u>. Three letter common words are <u>and</u>, <u>she</u>, <u>his</u>, and <u>her</u>.
