

WORD WRITING EXERCISE 1

Say the sounds, write her, win, said, where, has

- a. You're going to write the word (pause)
 her. Say the sounds in her. Get ready.
 (Tap for each sound as the children say:)
 h (pause) er.
- (Repeat until firm.)
- b. Everybody, write the word (pause) her. 🗸
- c. (Repeat steps a and b for win, said, where, and has.)

EXERCISE 2

Write bark, stop, ever, sing, of, dish

- a. You're going to write the word (pause) bark. Think about the sounds in bark and write the word.
- b. (Repeat step a for **stop**, **ever**, **sing**, **of**, and **dish**.)

SENTENCE WRITING EXERCISE 3

Write three sentences

- a. Listen to this sentence. That man went with him. Say that sentence. Get ready. (Signal.) That man went with him.
- b. Now you're going to say that sentence the slow way. Get ready. (Signal for each word as the children say:)
 That (pause) man (pause) went (pause) with (pause) him.
- c. Everybody, write the sentence. Spell each word the right way. ✓
- d. (Repeat steps *a*–*c* for **The men are in the barn** and **He has a ball.**)
