Convert Customary Measures of Capacity

Here's How



1 fluid ounce (floz)



1 c (c) 1 c = 8 floz



1 pint (pt) 1 pt = 2 c1 pt = 16 fl oz



1 quart (qt) 1 qt = 2 pt1 qt = 4 c1 qt = 32 fl oz



1 gallon (gal) 1 gal = 4 qt1 gal = 8 pt1 gal = 128 fl oz

You can convert (change or rename) customary units of liquid capacity.

How many fluid ounces are there in 2 cups?

2c = ? floz

 $2 \times 8 = 16$

Multiply by 8 because 1c = 8 fl oz.

2 c = 16 floz

How many pints are there in 4 cups?

4c = ? pt

 $4 \div 2 = 2$

4 c = 2 pt

Divide by 2 because 2 c = 1 pt.
