


Directions: Have students practice writing the letter Rr. Help them tell what is happening in each picture. Then have them write the letter r in the space to complete each word that begins or ends with r.

Directions: Students help Rocky Raccoon race to the finish line by drawing a line to each word and picture name that begins or ends with the letter *r*.

















































































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




Directions: Students cut apart the cards and tell what is happening in each one. They use the rhyme to put the events of the race in order and paste them on the racetrack.


